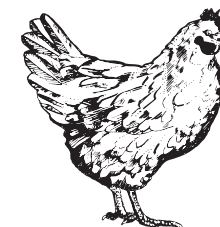
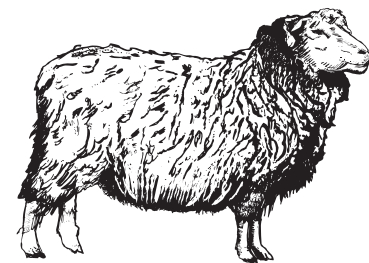


TIC TAC TOE..THREE IN A ROW! YOU KNOW HOW TO PLAY!
